2022 presented challenges + growth in many forms. we continued to cultivate partnerships with local community based organizations focused on food sovereignty, environmental justice, and economic equity work. we scaled our direct community impact by more than tripling the amount of in-kind food donations made between 2021 and 2022 to local community fridges. we marked a massive milestone by expanding our operations in a beloved local institution where we also supported the installation of an urban garden. and we collaborated with and cooked for some really incredible nonprofits. all of this as we continued cooking and kept the coffee flowing.

as we look to 2023, we hope to continue to deepen our relationships with local organizations advocating for justice and equity, increase our direct impact in the community in the form of food distribution and financial donations, and plan to enjoy a few good cups of coffee, plenty of baked goods, and many, many veggies along the way.

2022 highlights

FIRST EVER GARDEN-TO-TABLE DINNER

we collaborated with Riverdale Neighborhood House on our first ever garden-to-table dinner: a supper club style meal sourced from local farms and from Riverdale Neighborhood House's own garden. proceeds from this event supported Riverdale Neighborhood House's food justice work + leftovers from the meal went directly into The Neighborhood Fridge.



URBAN FARM + GARDEN PURCHASES

we actively worked to financially support local food systems last year. during the growing season, we made weekly purchases from local community gardens and urban farms and incorporated them into some beautiful specials and menu items.



COMMUNITY FUNDED

the Moss community donated just under \$4,000 to support our food distribution efforts and the work of local community organizations. community members tripled the amount of donations made this year from last to support food and economic justice through our monthly fundraising initiative.

GROW TORAH FUNDRAISER

we catered GrowTorah's Harvest Feast (in support of their Annual Fund) at Cropsey Community Farm.

THE BAYIT x MOSS CAFE

we partnered with The Bayit over the summer and offered a 26 week farm-share from Lancaster Farm Fresh Cooperative.

we expanded our operations and opened another location in a local high school.
